A. ORGANIZATION INFORMATION

A.1. The year of establishment and Legal Registration

Nawampate Dairy Cooperative Society Limited (NDCSL) was started in 2010 as a farmers' association to find a better market for farmers' milk through collective bulking and marketing. The association was started by seventy farmers who mobilized other members to join and start joint milk marketing in Mukono District. This was at a time when most farmers especially women were participating in the dairy development project that was being implemented by Heifer International. Some farmers had received heifers and there was increased milk production hence the need to identify better markets that offer higher prices. On the third of December 2012, Nawampate was legally registered as a cooperative society under number 10087/RCs. The purpose of this change to a cooperative was to acquire milk coolers and set up a milk bulking center where all milk would be collected and chilled before marketing. It was intended to formerly partner with different stakeholders including Dairy Development Authority (DDA) for development initiatives to improve farmers' livelihoods. Currently, Nawampate has 573 fully registered dairy member farmers where 396 are males and 177 are females.

A.2. The Mission or purpose for Nawampate Dairy Cooperative Society Ltd

The mission of Nawampate is to enhance farmers' standard of living through increased milk production techniques, high-quality breeds, and better business management practices. The key to be achieved include.

- 1) Improved quality of milk supplied by farmers to the cooperative.
- 2) Increased milk products marketed by the cooperative.
- 3) Increased number of farmers receiving services from the cooperative
- 4) Improved animal health through quality of animal drugs accessed by farmers from the veterinary shop.
- 5) Improved management practices through training and technical assistance

A.3. Significant achievement made by Nawampate Dairy Cooperative Society Limited in the past three years.

Year	Achievement
2023	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Acquired semi-automated yogurt processing equipment. Having utilized the equipment given previously, the Ministry of Trade and Cooperatives gave the cooperative additional equipment for yogurt processing. This included a batch pasteurizer, cooling tank and sealing machine.2. The cooperative made sales totaling 487,773 liters which generated a total of UGX 574,889,950.

2022	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Establishment of a Cooperative owned Veterinary Drug shop, the farmers had a serious challenge in accessing veterinary drugs but are now getting them at the cooperative over their milk deduction. These drugs are of high quality and farmers pay through deductions from their milk sales. 2. Purchased two Motorcycles using surpluses of the cooperatives, the Cooperative used its surpluses to procure two motorcycles to collect milk from the collecting centers. 3. Establishment of twenty (20) Pasture Demonstration gardens, as a way of helping the farmers to boost their feeding, the cooperative developed 20 demo gardens across the area boundaries. 4. Licensed to process milk into dairy products as a small-scale processor, the cooperative managed to register as a small-scale processor and received a processing license.

Installed the first equipment, In January 2022 the cooperative installed the first Yoghurt equipment and as well managed to extend the three-phase electricity supply to the cortege. 2. Purchased a milk cooler and generator using cooperative surpluses, Having been in existence for over 9 years, the cooperative made enough savings to be able to purchase a milk cooler of 600 litter capacity, 3. The cooperative also bought a standby generator which is being used when power goes off. This provided a springboard for increased milk collection.

A.4. Primary product that Nawampate sells for Revenue

Currently, the Cooperative sells Raw milk which accounts for 70% of the total revenue. Other sales include Yoghurt and veterinary inputs.

A.5. *Description of the ownership Structure*

Nawampate Dairy Co-operative Society Limited is a primary cooperative owned by dairy farmers in Mukonodistrict under the Cooperative ACT CAP 112. It is 100% percent owned and run by farmers who supply milk to the cooperative daily. The supreme decision-making organ is the general assembly (AGM) which sits once a year to make overall decisions that run the cooperative. The AGM comprises all farmers who have fully paid in their membership, and each has a least one share and is bulking daily to the cooperative. The cooperative has a constitution/by-law that guides the governance processes. The general assembly is responsible for electing a board of directors that is mandated to run the affairs of the cooperative on behalf of the shareholders. Also, the assembly elects a supervisory committee and assigns it the responsibility of regulatory and financial supervision. Currently, the shareholders of Nawampate come from four sub-counties include Mpatta, Nakisunga, Ntengyeru, Mpunge and Kisoga Town Council
